Help is Instantly On the Way With the Wireless Telemergency Phone System

Now you can always feel secure in your own home when you are alone and an emergency occurs. If you can't reach a phone, you can summon help fast from the wireless pendant or the base unit of the **Telemergency Phone System**. At the press of a button on the pendant or the base unit, your phone will automatically dial 911 and up to five other numbers (doctor, relative, neighbor, etc.). You can even record personalized messages for three different types of emergencies, such as medical, fire and burglary. A built-in speakerphone on the base unit let you speak directly to the person you



called so you can tell them about the nature and severity of the emergency, ask critical questions, and know that help is on the way. The vendor says that an internal back-up battery makes sure that the system will always function during a power failure. And best of all, there's no monthly fee or monitoring service involved. Just plug in the system and it's ready to use. According to the vendor, the effective range from the wireless pendant to the base unit is approximately 80 to 100 feet, depending on the physical structure and layout of your home. 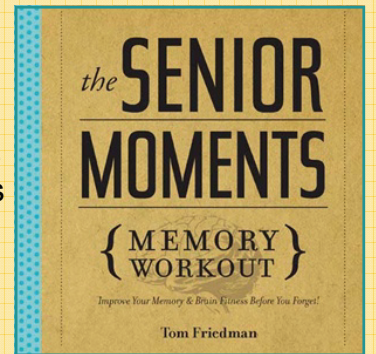
This Gadget Becomes a "Stirr" for Every Pot!

The **Stirr** "walks" around the pot, blending flavors and keeping ingredients from sticking or clumping, in effect stirring so you don't have to. The vendor says the soft padded feet won't scratch so it's safe for nonstick pots or pans. There's even a paddle that sweeps across the bottom of the pot.
